- College Entrance Examination Board and/or Graduate Record Examination Scores.
- Letter of academic record.
- Letter of recommendation from <u>one</u> of the following: College Instructor, College Counselor, or Board Member of your Rainbow or DeMolay Chapter.
- Copy of the first two pages of Federal Tax Return (Form 1040) for 2009 for <u>you</u> and <u>your parents</u> (unless you are self supporting).
